Reference: Police Facility / Security System

The police department has been preparing to replace/upgrade our current Security/Door Control System. Certain components of our current system have reached the end of life and will no longer be serviceable by the manufacturer and/or are obsolete. This expenditure has been listed on the five (5) year capitol budget and is slated for 2025 for which funds have also been budgeted.

We requested an updated quote from SECURITAS, which is attached to the resolution. The quoted cost for this project is \$121,110.05. The amount requested and budgeted is \$125,000.00. This will allow for any contingencies that may occur during the system upgrades such as patching or repair work, non-functioning cables or wiring discovered, etc.

The original system that was installed upon facility completion in 2002 was done by STANLEY Security. STANLEY was absorbed by SECURITAS Technology. We contacted multiple companies to review our current system and provide feedback and quotes for the upgrades and replacement for the obsolete system components. This system is integrated throughout the entire facility including the jail and dispatch center and is proprietary to SECURITAS. There were no other companies capable or willing to do these needed upgrades to our current system.
