Special Recognition of Poppy Days

WHEREAS, the poppy was named the memorial flower of the American Legion Auxiliary at the 1921 National Convention in Kansas City; and

WHEREAS, American Legion poppies are made by veterans in Auxiliary-sponsored “Poppy Shops” maintained and administered by Auxiliary volunteers, which are located in VA Medical Centers and other veterans’ facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson recognizes the American Legion Auxiliary and Legion family, who have pledged to remind Americans annually of the debt we owe to those who have served and died in the armed forces for our freedom.
