A RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 08-147 AND WITHDRAWING THE AUTHORIZATION GRANTED TO THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE VILLAGE OF BOSTON HEIGHTS FOR JOINT PLANNING AND ECONOMIC PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Resolution 08-147 authorized the City Manager to enter into a memorandum of understanding with the Village of Boston Heights to "comprehensively study, plan, and set in motion an agreement to enhance these mutual properties;" and

WHEREAS, the physical and economic landscape of the target area has significantly changed in the sixteen years since authorization was granted; and

WHEREAS, no study, plan, or agreement has been drafted or adopted by either municipal body in the sixteen years since authorization was granted; and

WHEREAS, the continued existence of this authorization provides unclear direction to current and future property owners; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. That Resolution No. 08-147, passed on November 5, 2008, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

<u>Section 2</u>. Upon its passage, the Clerk of Council is directed to deliver a copy of this Resolution to the Village of Boston Heights.

Section 3. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

<u>Section 4</u>. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 5.</u> This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
