The source of funding is the fund balance.
205	<u>Parks Fund:</u> Appropriate \$100,000 for sidewalk connectivity related to Phase 4 of the Veterans Trail project. Originally budgeted in 2018 but not started. The source of funding is carryover fund balance.
205	<u>Parks Fund:</u> Appropriate \$252,350 for Veterans Trail Phase 3 construction costs. The source of funding is the fund balance.
205	<u>Parks Fund:</u> Appropriate \$60,500 for Veterans Trail Phase 3 wetland mitigation costs. The source of funding is the fund balance.
206	<u>HCTV Fund:</u> Appropriate \$3,600 to purchase furniture and camera equipment for Good Day Hudson. The source of funding is donations from Laurel Lake, Margaret Clark Morgan Foundation, and Burton D Morgan Foundation.

430	Street & Sidewalk Construction Fund: Appropriate \$115,000 for S. Main St Design. Originally budgeted in 2018 but not started. The source of funding is carryover fund balance.
430	Street & Sidewalk Construction Fund: Appropriate \$65,292 to add Clinton Street Parking to the 2019 Concrete Program. The source of the funding is fund balance.
430	Street & Sidewalk Construction Fund: Appropriate \$279,925 for Middleton and Stone Roads resurfacing. The sources of funding are reimbursements from the Cities of Akron and Streetsboro respectively.
