A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT THE PARKS TENNIS & PICKLEBALL COURTS PROJECT PLAN TO THE HUDSON PLANNING COMMISSION FOR REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION PURSUANT TO CHARTER SECTION 9.02; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 21-86, passed by this Council on August 17, 2021, the City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract for the design phase of the City Tennis & Pickleball Court Complex to be constructed at the existing Barlow Farm Park; and

WHEREAS, the project includes the construction of park features and amenities for public access to tennis & pickleball courts; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Hudson Charter Section 9.02, no park or playground shall be constructed in the City of Hudson unless City Council has first submitted the proposed project to the Hudson Planning Commission for its report and recommendation; and

WHEREAS, prior to moving forward with the project, this Council requests that the Hudson Planning Commission make a report and recommendation back to this Council with respect to the proposed design, plan, and construction of a new Tennis & Pickleball Court Complex, pursuant to Section 9.02 of the Hudson Charter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to submit a report detailing the Tennis & Pickleball Court complex Project to the Hudson Planning Commission for a report and recommendation pursuant to Hudson Charter Section 9.02.

<u>Section 2</u>: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 3</u>: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary to further the public health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of Hudson at the earliest time possible and for the further reason that this project requires the coordination of several construction activities within the City and the ability to secure materials in a timely manner so that the project can be completed in the current construction season; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council except that six (6) affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
