

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE EQUIPMENT, MATERIALS, SUPPLIES, AND SERVICES FOR THE CITY'S PUBLIC UTILITY AND VELOCITY BROADBAND SERVICES OPERATIONS DURING THE YEAR 2026; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City's public utility operations and broadband service operations have immediate needs, from time to time, to purchase equipment, materials, supplies and services to continue their operations and for special projects; and

WHEREAS, due to the volatility of the market prices for these items, vendors only hold their prices for seven or so days at the most, making time of the essence; and

WHEREAS, better prices can be obtained for the City by obtaining quotations from various vendors on an as-needed basis; and

WHEREAS, the acquisition of these items serves to immediately affect, promote and protect life, health, property, safety, and the public peace; and

WHEREAS, there is currently budget authorization to purchase such items.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio:

Section 1. That the City Manager is authorized to purchase on an as-needed basis, after obtaining comparative quotations by various suppliers, equipment, materials, supplies and services needed for the City's public utility operations in an amount that may not exceed the 2026 approved budgeted amount as set forth in "Exhibit A," attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein.

Section 2. That the above recitals are fully incorporated as findings herein.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of life, health, property, safety, and the public peace and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to enter such agreements in a timely fashion due to market and offer conditions; wherefore, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage, provided it receives five (5) affirmative votes of members of Council, except that six (6) affirmative votes are required if all members are present; otherwise it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
