A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH GRINDLINE SKATEPARKS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE SKATEPARK AT VETERANS WAY PARK.

WHEREAS, City staff at the direction of City Council has solicited public bids for the construction of the Veterans Way Park Skatepark; and

WHEREAS, Staff has determined that the Grindline Co. possesses the bidder qualifications and submitted the lowest and best bid for said project; and

WHEREAS, City Council wishes to proceed with said skatepark project, staff recommends entering into a contract with the Grindline Skatepark Company for the skatepark construction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract on behalf of the City, subject to the affixing to the quotes by the Director of Finance of his certificate of availability of funds therefor, with Grindline Skateparks Company in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Eighty-Eight Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$388,250.00).

<u>Section 2</u>. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 3</u>. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
