

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH CENTURY EQUIPMENT FOR A CONTOUR MOWER FOR GOLF COURSE USE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson's Ellsworth Meadows Golf Club is in need of a replacement contour rotary mower as soon as possible to meet the needs of the golf course for the fast-approaching grass mowing season; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City Charter and ordinances and under State law, the City Manager may purchase goods or services through the Ohio Department of Administrative Services' Cooperative Purchasing Program when authorized by action of Council; and

WHEREAS, the City has obtained a price quote from Century Equipment, an authorized State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program vendor under State Term Contract #800261-ST515, for the purchase of a contour rotary mower, which price quote is \$29,563.05;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to enter into and execute on behalf of the City of Hudson a purchase agreement with Century Equipment for the purchase of a contour rotary mower at a total cost not to exceed \$29,563.05.

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized to appropriate to a proper account the funds necessary for the purchase authorized in Section 1 of this Resolution.

Section 3: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary for this purchase to be made to mow grass in this mowing season for the continued operation of a City service; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council elected thereto or six affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
