A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A LEASE AGREEMENT WITH SUNTRUST EQUIPMENT FINANCE & LEASING CORPORATION TO FINANCE A REMOUNT AMBULANCE VEHICLE FOR USE BY THE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Executive Summary: City Council previously approved a lease-purchase agreement with Excellance, Inc. for a remount ambulance. The remount is complete and ready for inspection and delivery to Hudson EMS. This resolution authorizes the lease agreement with SunTrust to finance the purchase.

Executive Summary: The 2014 Fleet Capital replacement budget currently has approved funding for the purchase of a replacement snow plow truck. Public Works Staff has identified a greater need to purchase an essential piece of equipment needed in the operational area of storm water maintenance and construction and wishes to discuss a purchase plan option with City Council.

B. 14-0018 Discussion: Hudson Crossing Parkway connection to Boston Mills Road.

Executive Summary: Council's discussions concerning the proposed rezoning of a parcel from District 6 to District 3 for an expansion to proposed Reserve at River Oaks have generated discussions about the formerly proposed connection between SR303 and Boston Mills Road via Hudson Crossing Parkway. Council's understanding of the status of this connection may have bearing on its decision concerning the zoning map amendment.
