

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CHANGE ORDER TO THE CONTRACT WITH RONYAK PAVING, INC. UNDER THE 2015 ASPHALT RESURFACING AND RECONSTRUCTION PROGRAM FOR BARLOW FARM PARK; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to public bid, this Council awarded the 2015 Asphalt Resurfacing and Reconstruction Program contract to Ronyak Paving, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds that it is necessary to amend the aforesaid contract in accordance with a recommendation of the City Manager to authorize additional funds as a change order for completion of the resurfacing of the parking lot and drive areas at Barlow Farm Park due to unforeseen circumstances arising during construction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: A change order in the amount of \$32,515.00 to the 2015 Asphalt Resurfacing and Reconstruction Program contract with Ronyak Paving, Inc., is approved.

Section 2: The Director of Finance is directed to appropriate to a proper account the funds necessary for the change order authorized in Section 1 of this Resolution.

Section 3: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to complete the asphalt work at Barlow Farm Park at the earliest possible time for the safety of the motoring public and to do so during this construction season; wherefore, this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council elected thereto, except that six (6) affirmative votes shall be required if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
