A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICE CONTRACT WITH TRANSYSTEMS FOR ENGINEERING DESIGN SERVICES FOR THE STOW ROAD AND MIDDLETON ROAD TRAFFIC SIGNAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson (City) requested proposals from experienced consultants for the design of a traffic signal at Stow Road and Middleton Road; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends awarding a contract to TranSystems for professional services to design a new traffic signal at the intersection of Stow Road and Middleton Road in the amount of Seventy-One Thousand Twenty-Five Dollars and Eleven Cents (\$71,025.11), which includes a 10% contingency; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to award said contract to the TranSystems of Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Manager is authorized to enter into a professional service contract with TranSystems for professional engineering design services for the Project, in an amount, including contingency, not to exceed Seventy-One Thousand Twenty-Five Dollars and Eleven Cents (\$71,025.11).

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
