

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR COMPETITIVE BIDS AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR HINES HILL ROAD AND VALLEY VIEW ROAD SIDEWALK PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City plans to install sidewalks along Valley View Road and Hines Hill Road, which work is currently budgeted for construction as part of the 2020-2025 Connectivity Program; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed sidewalk alignment will be along the west side of Valley View Road from Hunting Hollow Drive to Hines Hill Road, the east side of Valley View Road from Hines Hill Road to Wethersfield Drive and the north side of Hines Hill Road from Granby Drive to Glastonbury Drive; and,

WHEREAS, the sidewalk construction also includes storm drainage improvements, grading, crosswalks, lighting, electric conduits, driveways, and minor clearing and restoration; and,

WHEREAS, the estimated total cost of construction is \$2,055,000, which includes a 10% contingency; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City of Hudson and its residents that this project be completed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to advertise both for a period of at least once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipality and for a period of three (3) consecutive weeks on the Municipal website, requesting the submission of bids for the award and enter into a contract for the aforesaid Valley View Road and Hines Hill Road Sidewalk Project in accordance with the specifications as supplied by and on file with the City Engineer's office.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to do all things necessary to award, enter and then implement a contract for the Valley View Road and Hines Hill Road 2020-2025 Connectivity Program subject to the affixing to the contract by the Finance Director of a certificate of availability of funds therefore, with the lowest and best bidder after receipt of such bids to the extent that such bid shall not exceed \$2,055,000, the amount budgeted for this project, including contingency.

Section 3. The City Manager is further authorized to return all certified checks and bid bonds submitted by the unsuccessful bidders and to reject all bids for said contract if deemed necessary to do so.

Section 4. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 6. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
