A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE NORTH MAIN STREET STORM SEWER IMPROVEMENT PROJECT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to improve the storm sewer system along North Main Street, south of Brandywine Drive, and at the Markillie-St. Mary's Cemetery Chapel in Hudson.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager is authorized to advertise for a period of at least two consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipality, requesting the submission of bids for the improvement of the storm sewer system along North Main Street, south of Brandywine Drive, and at the Markillie-St. Mary's Cemetery Chapel in Hudson in accordance with the specifications as supplied by the City Engineer's office.
- Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract or contracts on behalf of the City, subject to the affixing to the contract by the Finance Director of a certificate of availability of funds therefor, with the lowest and best bidder after receipt of such bids to the extent that such bid shall not exceed seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000.00), the Engineer's estimated project cost and amount budgeted for this project.
- <u>Section 3</u>. The City Manager is authorized to add a 10% contingency amount to the contract with the lowest and best bidder.
- <u>Section 4</u>. The City Manager is further authorized to return all certified checks and bid bonds submitted by the unsuccessful bidders and to reject any and all bids for said contract, if she deems it is necessary to do so.
- Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- Section 6. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to perform the storm sewer improvements as soon as possible to help alleviate flooding issues in the specified areas; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council, except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise,

it shall be in full force and effect from and	after the earliest period allowed by law.
