A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION BY THE CITY MANAGER'S DESIGNEE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY FOR A FEMA FIRE PREVENTION & SAFETY GRANT FOR THE HUDSON FIRE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the Department of Homeland Security, through the Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA"), administers financial assistance to enhance the safety of the public and firefighters with respect to fire and fire-related hazards by assisting fire prevention programs and supporting firefighter health and safety research and development through the FEMA Fire Prevention and Safety Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the FEMA Fire Prevention and Safety Grant Program could provide a 95% / 5% matching grant (the "Grant") up to approximately \$51,000, requiring the City to match up to approximately \$2,550, to help fund a fire prevention program for the at-risk senior citizen population, which would include installation of residential Knox boxes and smoke detectors for the hearing-impaired in one hundred (100) homes; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has submitted such a Grant application by the deadline of May 19, 2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1.</u> Council hereby affirms the City Manager's Designee's actions to submit an application to the Department of Homeland Security, having provided all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance under the Grant program as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 3.</u> This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
