

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH SECURITAS TECHNOLOGY CORPORATION FOR THE PURCHASE OF SECURITY AND INTERCOM SYSTEM UPGRADES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson recognizes the importance of maintaining an up-to-date and reliable security and intercom system for the safety and security of City facilities and personnel; and

WHEREAS, Securitas Technology Corporation has been identified as the single most qualified vendor for the purchase and installation of the required security and intercom system upgrades; and

WHEREAS, the City's current system is integrated throughout the Police Department's entire facility, including the jail and dispatch center, and is proprietary to Securitas, and there are no other companies willing and/or able to complete the contemplated upgrades; and

WHEREAS, the City staff has determined that the total cost for the purchase and installation of the replacement security and intercom system upgrades is approximately \$125,000; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to proceed with the purchase agreement and ensure that the necessary upgrades are made promptly to maintain the safety and security of City facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager and his designee are hereby authorized to sign all necessary paperwork and to enter and administer a contract with Securitas Technology Corporation for the purchase and security and intercom system upgrades, in an amount not to exceed \$125,000, subject to the terms and conditions as determined and approved by the City Solicitor.

Section 2. The City Manager and Finance Director are hereby authorized to spend up to \$125,000 budget authorization for said equipment.

Section 3. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of life, health, property, public peace, safety and welfare of the City's staff and residents, and to allow for the prompt and cost efficient upgrades that are not available from any other known source, and shall, therefore, be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives an affirmative vote of at least six (6) members of the Council for its enactment if seven (7) are present, or an affirmative vote of at least five (5) members if only five (5) or six (6) members are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
