

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 22-25 AMENDING THE INTERCONNECTION POLICY FOR CONNECTION OF RESIDENTIAL AND/OR COMMERCIAL SOLAR POWER GENERATION SYSTEMS TO THE CITY OF HUDSON'S POWER GRID

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 22-25 passed by this Council on March 15, 2022, amending the City's Interconnection Policy for the connection of residential and/or commercial solar power generation systems to the City of Hudson's power grid to accommodate increased system sizes up to 25kW for residential installations and 200kW for commercial installations;

WHEREAS, the Hudson Public Power staff has received commercial and industrial requests for solar generation system interconnections that exceed 200kW;

WHEREAS, it is determined by this Council that the interconnection policy shall include the consideration and evaluation of commercial and industrial solar generation system requests which exceed 200Kw on a case-by-case basis as approved by Hudson Public Power

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: This Council adopts an amendment to the Interconnection Policy that was amended by the passage of Ordinance 22-25 of this Council in order for the connection of commercial and industrial solar powered generation systems to the City of Hudson's power grid to include consideration and evaluation on a case-by-case basis of requests for systems exceeding 200kW and as reviewed and approved by Hudson Public Power as detailed in "Exhibit A" attached hereto and incorporated into this Ordinance.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
