Italianate, with Greek Revival influence remaining. Pedimented off-center entrance, hipped roof with brackets; windows with narrow muntins and pedimented lintels. The present kitchen is an 1873 addition, built over crawl space; the roof over the addition was raised in the 1970s.

Elizabeth Shaw was the wife of Calvin Shaw, a carpenter, who came to Hudson from Massachusetts in 1865 and probably built this house.

There are faint echoes of Greek Revival in the style of this house. The front windows have been altered; the panels are a later addition and modification. There are two additions to the rear.

Samuel Bediant was a machinist who owned or leased a number of houses in Hudson; in 1909 he built the house at 287 North Main Street (206).


