A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE NORFOLK SOUTHERN RAILROAD CULVERT IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: The City Manager is authorized and directed to advertise in accordance with law a request for submission of bids for the culvert improvement project consisting of the installation of a new 36-inch storm sewer system for improved drainage from the area between SR 303 and Owen Brown Street on the westside of the Norfolk Southern Railroad Tracks.

SECTION 2: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Hudson by reason of the necessity to allow the project of public necessity to proceed at the earliest possible time to alleviate flooding; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council, except that six (6) affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
