- **Section 4** That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to make expenditures or payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certifications and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve same or an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance.
- **Section** <u>5</u> It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
