A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH INDEPENDENCE BUSINESS SUPPLY FOR THE PURCHASE OF TABLES AND CHAIRS FOR THE COMMUNITY ROOMS AT THE CITY HALL BUILDING, LOCATED AT 1140 TEREX ROAD.

WHEREAS, in order to hold meetings or events <u>in the lower level Community Rooms</u> at the new City Hall Building, located at 1140 Terex Road, it is necessary to purchase tables and chairs for the public meeting spaces; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City Charter and state law, this Council has the authority by legislative enactment such as this Resolution to authorize a purchase of equipment through a competitive bid obtained through a cooperative purchasing program, which for this purchase is through Ohio State Term Schedule Contract No. STS714, with Independence Business Supply providing said tables and chairs for the total price of \$18,325.25\$36,909.31; and

WHEREAS, staff has recommended that the City enter into a contract with Independence Business Supply for said tables and chairs; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined to authorize said contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Independence Business Supply for the purchase of tables and chairs for the new City Hall Building in an amount not to exceed <u>Eighteen Thousand Three Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars and Twenty-Five Cents</u> (\$18,325.25) <u>Thirty-Six Thousand Nine Hundred Nine Dollars and Thirty-One Cents</u> (\$36,909.31), and the contract shall be in a form acceptable to the City Manager and City Solicitor.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 3</u>. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
