OFFERED BY: MAYOR CURRIN

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR COMPETITIVE BIDS FOR THE CAPITAL MAINTENANCE PROGRAMS OF THE CITY OF HUDSON; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, certain streets in the City of Hudson, Ohio, require routine maintenance in order to preserve and protect them.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized and directed to advertise for a period of at least once a week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipality, requesting the submission of bids for the routine maintenance of various streets in the City of Hudson, Ohio, to include the annual reconstruction/resurfacing program, the annual concrete replacement program, the annual crack sealing program and the annual striping and painting program in accordance with the specifications as supplied by the City Manager's Office.

<u>Section 2</u>: The City Manager is further authorized and directed to return all certified checks and bid bonds submitted by the unsuccessful bidders.

Section 3: This Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary to complete the competitive bidding process for the subject work that is critical to maintaining public safety and to do so at the earliest possible time so as to complete the work in the 2014 construction season; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council, except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
