OFFERED BY: MAYOR BASIL

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HER DESIGNEE, TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE SUMMIT COUNTY SAFETY COUNCIL FOR A GRANT TO FUND AN AUTOMATIC EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR (AED); AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, use of an Automatic External Defibrillator (AED) can greatly increase a victim's chance of survival; and

WHEREAS, the Summit County Safety Council provides annual funding to one entity located in Summit County for the purchase of a new AED; and

WHEREAS, the Summit County Safety Council could provide funding up to \$2,000 for one AED device to replace one aging device that belongs to the City of Hudson.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to apply to the Summit County Safety Council for an AED grant for the reason set forth in the recitals to this Resolution.

Section 2: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare of the City and its residents and for the reason that it is necessary to apply for this grant without delay to timely meet the deadline for submission of the application and to enhance the possibility of receiving the same; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council, except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
