

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR REPLACEMENT OF THE RETAINING WALL AT EDGEVIEW DRIVE AND SR 91.

WHEREAS, the City's Traffic Safety Committee identified the existing wall on State Route 91 (Darrow Drive) as creating a site distance constraint for vehicles turning off of Edgeview Drive onto SR 91; and

WHEREAS, The project will include the lowering of the block wall, grading and restoration at Edgeview Drive to improve site distances at the intersection, as well as reconstruction of a portion of the existing retaining wall at 7436 Darrow Road which has settled since its original construction; and

WHEREAS, the Engineer's revised estimate for the project is \$66,500.00, which includes a 10% contingency and is already budgeted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to advertise both for a period of at least once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipality and for a period of three (3) consecutive weeks on the Municipal website, requesting the submission of construction bids for the purpose of seeking the lowest and best bidder for the retaining wall at Edgeview Drive and SR 91 in accordance with the specifications as supplied by the City Engineer's office.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract or contracts on behalf of the City in the amount appropriated by Council, subject to the affixing to the contract by the Finance Director of a certificate of availability of funds therefor, with the lowest and best bidder after receipt of such bids not to exceed sixty six thousand five hundred dollars (\$66,500.00), the Engineer's estimate with an additional 10% contingency.

Section 3. The City Manager is further authorized to return all certified checks and bid bonds submitted by the unsuccessful bidders and to reject all bids for said contract if deemed necessary to do so.

Section 4. That the above recitals are fully incorporated as findings herein.

Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including

Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
