

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH BAKER VEHICLE SYSTEMS INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO ZERO TURN TRIM MOWERS FOR PARK USE.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson's Parks Department is requesting the replacement of two (2) existing zero turn mowers as the City's current equipment has exceeded its useful life based on age, hours, and wear and tear; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson has the authority to purchase equipment through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program which entity employs competitive bidding processes for equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City has obtained a price quote from Baker Vehicle System Inc., Macedonia, Ohio, an authorized State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program vendor under State Term Contract #031121-HTE, for the purchase of two (2) Zero Turn Trim Mowers in an amount of \$26,501.00, for use in maintaining the parks grounds; and

WHEREAS, this Council has appropriated the funds necessary for the purchase of said equipment to replace equipment in the Parks Division.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with Baker Vehicle System Inc., Macedonia, Ohio, under the State of Ohio Procurement State Term Schedule Contract #031121-HTE for the purchase of two (2) Zero Turn Trim Mowers in an amount not to exceed \$26,501.00, and as said amount has been appropriated in the City budget.

Section 2. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
