A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS NETWORK, LLC; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City must renew and upgrade its emergency communications services which includes its "Reverse 9-1-1" calling and text messages service to continue that service to residents and Emergency Communications Network, LLC is the current contractor for those services and a sole source provider of those services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio. that:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager is authorized to enter into an agreement, with Emergency Communications Network, LLC for "Reverse 9-1-1" calling and texting services at a total cost of \$29,284.96, for a term of three years and 244 days.

Section 2. This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to enter into the agreement to insure that the necessary Reverse 9-1-1 services continue to be provided on an uninterrupted basis; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
