



## Hudson City Schools 1927 Building

### Information for Inclusion in Submission to Architectural and Historic Board of Review

#### Salvage

The Hudson City School District Board of Education may accept a proposal by the Hudson Heritage Association to allow HHA the opportunity to remove and salvage portions of the front façade of the building (refer to marked photos below). HHA's proposal includes a base scope of salvage as well as an additional scope, depending upon the funding HHA commits. If the Board of Education accepts HHA's proposal, the salvaged components will be retained by HHA and may be utilized in the future for some repurposed tribute to the building. There is no funding currently in place to accommodate the repurposing of the salvaged façade components.



#### Staging During Demolition

The area utilized to perform the demolition activity will be minimized in order to reduce impacts to the surrounding lawn and trees. The mature Oak Tree allee in front of the building will be outside of the demolition work space, and will not be impacted. Shrubs and small trees directly adjacent to the

building will need to be removed so that the building foundations can be removed and backfill can be placed. Access to and from the demolition site will be from Oviatt Street, using the school driveway.

**Haul Route**

Trucks removing the demolition debris and bringing in soil for backfill will access the site from Oviatt Street. Two options exist for the haul route. Trucks leaving will either (1) head north on Oviatt Street and east on Aurora Street, or (2) head south on Oviatt Street and east on East Streetsboro Street. The City's input will determine which of these routes will be used.
