

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR COMPETITIVE BIDS AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE CITY HALL AWNING AND CANOPY PROJECT.

WHEREAS, this Council seeks to add a weather awning over the double door entrance to the City Hall Community Rooms and a canopy to cover a bench at the rear of City Hall rear entry sidewalk adjacent to the existing parking lot; and,

WHEREAS, the City has received a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) grant which will cover the majority of the project's cost; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City of Hudson and its residents that this project be completed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to advertise both for a period of at least once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipality and for a period of three (3) consecutive weeks on the Municipal website, requesting the submission of bids for the aforesaid City Hall Awning and Canopy Project, in accordance with the specifications as supplied by and on file with the City Manager's office and/or the Public Works Department.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to do all things necessary to enter into and implement a contract for the City Hall Awning and Canopy project subject to the affixing to the contract by the Finance Director of a certificate of availability of funds therefor, with the lowest and best bidder after receipt of such bids to the extent that such bid shall not exceed \$43,615.00, the amount budgeted for this project (including the authorized 10% contingency).

Section 3. The City Manager is authorized to add a ten percent (10%) contingency amount to the contract with the lowest and best bidder.

Section 4. The City Manager is further authorized to return all certified checks and bid bonds submitted by the unsuccessful bidders and to reject all bids for said contract if deemed necessary to do so.

Section 5. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 6. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council,

and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 7. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
