

A RESOLUTION RENEWING THE DESIGNATION OF REPUBLIC SERVICES AS THE CITY'S PREFERRED TRASH AND RECYCLING VENDOR AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A SERVICE CONTRACT WITH REPUBLIC SERVICES.

WHEREAS, in 2016, after studying the issue of trash and recycling pick up and disposal services over an extended period of time, City Council designated Republic Services as the City's preferred trash and recycling service vendor for reasons of efficiency and economy for the City and for property owners in the City; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires that the City Manager enter into a renewal contract with Republic Services for the aforesaid services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. This Council hereby designates Republic Services as the preferred trash and recycling vendor in the City of Hudson and authorizes the City Manager to proceed with preparing and entering into a renewal service contract with Republic Services for trash and recycling services.

Section 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
