

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A TWO-YEAR CONTRACT WITH M.A.T. CLEANING SERVICE FOR HOUSEKEEPING / CLEANING SERVICES AT CITY OFFICES AND PUBLIC BUILDINGS.

WHEREAS, the current contract for housekeeping and general cleaning services at city offices and public buildings will expire on December 31, 2017; and

WHEREAS, competitive bids were solicited for said housekeeping and general cleaning services for the two-year time period from January 1, 2018, through December 31, 2019 with an option for a two-year renewal at the end of the two-year term. M.A.T. Cleaning Service was the sole bidder; and

WHEREAS, the City's past experience with M.A.T. Cleaning Service has been satisfactory and their current bid is reasonable.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to enter into a two (2)-year contract with M.A.T. Cleaning Service of Stow, Ohio, for a term to begin January 1, 2018, and to run through December 31, 2019, in an amount not to exceed \$87,138.63 per year, which includes a fifteen percent (15%) contingency amount for unknown additional work, with the City's option to renew the contract for an additional two (2)-year period at a cost not to exceed the amount of Council appropriations therefor.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution will take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
