A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A \$2,000 RACIAL AND DIVERSITY AWARENESS GRANT FROM THE BURTON D. MORGAN FOUNDATION FOR DIVERSITY, EQUITY, AND INCLUSION TRAINING.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson was awarded, and the City Manager recently accepted a Racial and Diversity Awareness Grant from the Burton D. Morgan Foundation in the amount of \$2,000 to fund diversity, equity, and inclusion training to benefit the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. This Council affirms the City Manager's acceptance of a grant from the Burton D. Morgan Foundation in the amount of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) for the purpose set forth in the recital to this Resolution.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
