

A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY FOR A PRIORITY ONE AND SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Medical Services, awards Priority One and Supplemental grant funding for safety and emergency medical response equipment, training, and research; and

WHEREAS, authorized under Section 4765.07 of the Ohio Revised Code, the program is intended to help agencies maintain high standards of patient care, improve response effectiveness, and ensure that providers are trained and equipped with the tools necessary to serve their communities safely and efficiently; and

WHEREAS, the next Priority One Grant will provide reimbursement-based funding to eligible EMS agencies for approved training and equipment purchases completed within a defined grant cycle (July 1, 2026 – December 31, 2026); and

WHEREAS, Hudson EMS has historically submitted successful reimbursement requests for eligible equipment under this grant;

WHEREAS, Hudson EMS is committed to ensuring its members are consistently trained and equipped to meet best-in-class standards.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. That the City Manager and/or his designee are hereby authorized to prepare and/or execute on behalf of the City any applications and all related paperwork for the Ohio Department of Public Safety for a Priority One and Supplemental grant. Any actions taken in this regard to date are hereby ratified and affirmed. If the grant is awarded, the City Manager and/or his designee are further authorized to do all things necessary in order to qualify for and administer the grant funding and to otherwise implement the intentions of this Resolution.

Section 2. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
