## A RESOLUTION APPOINTING SCOTT N. SCHROYER AS INTERIM CITY MANAGER; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Section 5.04 of the City Charter authorizes this Council to appoint an Interim City Manager for to exercise the powers and duties of the office of City Manager when that office is vacant and until a City Manager is appointed; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to appoint Scott N. Schroyer, current Assistant City Manager, to the position of Interim City Manager to exercise the powers and duties of the office of City Manager due to the separation from employment of Anthony J. Bales as the City Manager.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>: This Council hereby appoints Scott N. Schroyer to be Interim City Manager effective upon the passage of this Resolution for the reasons set forth in the preamble to this Resolution.

Section 2: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the general welfare of the City and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to continue the usual daily operations of this City to provide services and other daily functions of the municipal government; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council elected thereto or six affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
