

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF ROAD SALT THROUGH THE COMMUNITY UNIVERSITY EDUCATION PURCHASING ASSOCIATION (C.U.E.) PROGRAM FOR THE 2013-2014 WINTER SEASON; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson, as a member of the C.U.E. purchasing program, may purchase road salt under the C.U.E.'s public bidding procedures; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended purchasing of road salt through the C.U.E. program from Cargill Deicing Technology Company, Incorporated for the 2013-2014 winter season.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. For the 2013-2014 winter season, the City Manager is authorized and directed to purchase the City's road salt requirements from Cargill Deicing Technology Company, Incorporated at \$39.84 per ton.

SECTION 2. The Director of Finance is directed to appropriate to a proper fund the costs for the salt and services required by the contract authorized in Section 1 hereof.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to be ready for this winter season; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
