

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH O.C.I. CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR BROADBAND CONDUIT AND FIBER OPTIC CABLE INSTALLATION ON GEORGETOWN ROAD AND HUDSON INDUSTRIAL PARKWAY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, competitive bids were received for installation of broadband conduit and fiber optic cable on Georgetown Road and Hudson Industrial Parkway; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works has recommended that the bid of O.C.I. Construction, Inc. be accepted by this Council as being the lowest and best bid; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to accept the bid of O.C.I. Construction, Inc. as being the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The bid of O.C.I. Construction, Inc. for the installation of broadband conduit and fiber optic cable on Georgetown Road and Hudson Industrial Parkway, being the lowest and best bid, is accepted and the City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into a contract with O.C.I. Construction, Inc. for the total amount of \$240,183, which includes a 15% contingency.

Section 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council or committees, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.

Section 3. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare and for the further reason that the aforesaid services be expedited for the provision of public services; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council elected thereto or six affirmative votes if all members of council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
