

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF STREETSBORO FOR COOPERATION AND COST SHARING FOR THE RESURFACING OF STONE ROAD.

WHEREAS, the proposed project is to resurface Stone Road from SR 303 to Hale Drive; and

WHEREAS, under an agreement between the City of Hudson and the City of Streetsboro (“Agreement”), the City of Hudson is taking the lead to enter into agreements for the resurfacing services work and to administer the same for the Stone Road Resurfacing Project at a total project cost not to exceed One Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand One Hundred Eighty-Eight Dollars and Thirty Four Cents (\$178,188.34), which this Council has previously appropriated; and

WHEREAS, under the Agreement, the City of Streetsboro will be responsible for fifty percent (50%) of the estimated total project costs in an amount not to exceed Eighty-Nine Thousand Ninety-Four Dollars and Seventeen Cents (\$89,094.17), which the City Council of Streetsboro has previously appropriated by ordinance and which is to be paid to the City of Hudson through reimbursements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into an agreement with the City of Streetsboro for cooperation and cost sharing for the Stone Road Resurfacing Project as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
