A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER'S DESIGNEE TO APPLY TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES, FOR AN EMS PRIORITY ONE TRAINING AND EQUIPMENT GRANT ON BEHALF OF HUDSON EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES AND ACCEPTANCE OF AWARDED FUNDING.

WHEREAS, the City seeks funding from the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Medical Services, through an EMS Priority One Training and Equipment Grant to fund training and/or equipment listed on the Training and Equipment List/Expenditures Form as approved by the Ohio Emergency Medical, Fire and Transportation Services (EMFTS) Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, as follows:

- <u>Section 1.</u> The City Manager and/or his designee are authorized to submit an application to the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Medical Services, for an EMS Priority One Training and Equipment Grant and acceptance of awarded funding.
- <u>Section 2.</u> The City Manager and/or his designee is authorized to accept any awarded funds in conjunction with the EMS Priority One Training and Equipment Grant.
- <u>Section 3.</u> That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.
- Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
