A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADOPT THE SITE NAME "HUDSON INNOVATION PARK" AND DEVELOP SITE BRANDING FOR THE CITY-OWNED PARCEL AT 996 HINES HILL ROAD.

WHEREAS, the Community Development Department is pursuing an "authentication" certification with JobsOhio's SiteOhio program for 996 Hines Hill Road, commonly known presently as the "YDC property," with the goal of generating more high-quality leads for the acreage; and

WHEREAS, one of the recommendations for authentication is to develop a site name and other branding; and

WHEREAS, the City administration seeks approval of the name "Hudson Innovation Park" and a new logo to be leveraged in marketing materials going forward.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager and his designees are hereby authorized to adopt new branding for the City-owned parcels at 996 Hines Hill Road, including the site name "Hudson Innovation Park."
- <u>Section 2</u>. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.
- Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
