OFFERED BY: MAYOR CURRIN

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 840.02(b) OF CHAPTER 840, "PEDDLERS AND SOLICITORS", OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the deadline for door-to-door noncommercial solicitation or canvassing during Eastern Standard Time in the City is being changed from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on weekdays and Saturdays to parallel the same time deadline during Daylight Savings Time;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. Subsection 840.02(b) of Chapter 840, "Peddlers and Solicitors", is amended to hereinafter read as follows:

"840.02 HOURS OF SOLICITATION REGULATED.

- (b) During standard time no noncommercial solicitation shall be conducted before 9:00 a.m. or after 7:00 <u>9:00</u> p.m. on weekdays, Saturdays and Sundays or at any time on a State or national holiday. During daylight savings time no noncommercial solicitation shall be conducted before 9:00 a.m. or after 9:00 p.m. on weekdays, Saturdays and Sundays, or at any time on a State or national holiday."
- <u>Section 2</u>. Existing Subsection 840.02(b) is hereby repealed.

<u>Section 3</u>. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public welfare and due to legal considerations; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council, except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
