**RE:** Water Expansion – Estimated General Fund Impact

**MEETING:** June 20, 2023

At the June 13, 2023 workshop, City Council requested staff provide the estimated impact on the General Fund if the City contributed 25% of the construction cost of extending water lines within the various subdivisions discussed at the workshop.

The estimated impact is a follows:

The General Fund's 25% share of all the projects would be \$8,384,969. If the project costs are financed, the General Fund's share of the annual debt service for all five areas would be \$537,872 per year for 20 years.

## **Key Assumptions:**

- 1. The construction costs of all five projects could be financed with state agency loans at 2.5% for 20 years.
- 2. Sales revenue and tap fee revenue from new customers would go into the Water Fund and therefore would not go toward the new debt.
- 3. Area 3 (Nicholson) does not receive the \$4 million grant.
