BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: The City Manager is authorized and directed to advertise in accordance with law a request for submission of bids for the Hudson Drive Resurfacing Project as detailed to this Council by the City Engineer and to include an alternative bid item for the widening of street berms.

SECTION 2: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Hudson by reason of the necessity to allow the project of public necessity to proceed at the earliest possible time for the safety of the motoring public and to complete the project within the 2014 construction season; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council, except that six (6) affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
