A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT FROM LAUREL LAKE RESIDENTS ASSOCATION BY THE CITY MANAGER'S DESIGNEE ON BEHALF OF THE HUDSON EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the Laurel Lake Residents Association has granted \$50,000 to Hudson Emergency Medical Services to purchase equipment for Hudson's three existing advanced life support ambulances and the reserve ambulance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>: This Council affirms acceptance by the City Manager's designee of a grant from Laurel Lake Residents Association in the amount of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) for the purpose set forth in the recitals to this Resolution.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 3.</u> This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
