101	General Fund: Appropriate \$91,666 for job creation tax credit payments. The source of funding is the fund balance.
101	General Fund: Appropriate \$25,000 for Town Hall 2 nd floor reconfiguration (conference table, new chairs for Council and two work desks). The source of funding is the fund balance.
101	General Fund: Appropriate \$12,000 for temporary employee services in Public Works Administration. The source of funding is the fund balance.
201	<u>Street Maintenance Fund:</u> Appropriate \$42,000 for additional road salt purchases to meet our minimum purchase requirement. The source of funding is a transfer from the General Fund.
224	EMS Fund: Appropriate \$3,500 for a training grant received from the State. The source of funding is the grant.
476	Atterbury Blvd Reconstruction: Appropriate \$72,039.50 to transfer the balance in the construction fund to the debt service fund. The source of funding is the remaining debt proceeds from the project.

Also appropriate \$64,000 for fuel purchases to cover costs through the end of the year. The source of funding is the inter-departmental chargeback.
705	<u>Tree Trust Fund:</u> Appropriate \$400 for a memorial tree planting. The source of funding is a private donation.
740	<u>Library Levy Fund:</u> Appropriate \$38,429 for the library levy proceeds and related fees that pass through the City. The source of funding is the levy proceeds.
