

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH THE TRANSYSTEMS CORPORATION OF OHIO FOR THE MIDDLETON ROAD AND STOW ROAD SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson requested a formal statement of qualifications and proposals from experienced consultants for the Middleton Road and Stow Road Sidewalk Improvement Project (hereinafter, the "Project") for the survey, analysis, and design of the the Project; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends awarding a contract to the TranSystems Corporation of Ohio for professional services to survey, analyze and design a 5-foot sidewalk on Middleton Road from Valley View Road to the ODOT I-480 Bridge and on Stow Road from Middleton Road to Pine Trails, in an amount of Three-Hundred Thirty-Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty-Eight Dollars (\$339,858.00), which includes a 10% contingency; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to award said contract to the TranSystems Corporation of Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to enter into a professional services contract with the TranSystems Corporation of Ohio for professional consulting services for the Project, in an amount of Three-Hundred Thirty-Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty-Eight Dollars (\$339,858.00).

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
