Special Recognition of the Peg's Foundation 25th Anniversary

WHEREAS, Peg's Foundation namesake, Margaret "Peg" Clark Morgan, was born on September 5, 1918, in Kent, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, Peg was the great-great-granddaughter of Owen Brown, father of abolitionist John Brown; and

WHEREAS, Peg graduated from Theodore Roosevelt High School as valedictorian and pursued a degree in business from Miami University at a time when few women pursued a college degree; and

WHEREAS, in 1939, Peg began working at Goodrich in Akron, where she met Burton D. Morgan and together they built a family and life rooted in entrepreneurship; and

WHEREAS, in 2001, the Margaret Clark Morgan Foundation was established in Peg's honor; and she focused on improve the lives of people with serious mental illness; and

WHEREAS, "25 Years of Impact", a gallery on view through September 5, 2026, traces the evolution of a vision first imagined by Peg Morgan and carried forward by those who believe in the power of giving to change lives.
