A RESOLUTION REJECTING BIDS FOR THE STOW ROAD/STATE ROUTE 303 STORM SEWER IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the general welfare of the City of Hudson and by reason of the necessity to allow return of all bid bonds to the bidders at the earliest possible time and without undue delay; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council, except that six (6) affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law
