A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF SEVEN-FIFTY ML, LLC FOR THE DESIGNATION AS AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROJECT AND IN SUPPORT OF ITS APPLICATION FOR THE TRANSFER OF A LIQUOR LICENSE.

WHEREAS, upon discussions between the City Manager, City Economic Development Director, and Seven-Fifty ML, LLC, the City Manager and Economic Development Director have recommended that a proposed business project within the City of Hudson by said company should be designated as an "economic development project," as that term is used in Ohio Revised Code § 4303.29(B)(3)(b) and that the transfer of a liquor license for that business to be before the Ohio Department of Commerce, Division of Liquor Control should be encouraged.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>: This Council supports a business project proposed by Seven-Fifty ML, LLC in the City of Hudson as an "economic development project" as that term is used in the Ohio Revised Code, and expresses its belief that this business will be a beneficial addition to the City of Hudson by increasing jobs within the City and the City's tax base.

<u>Section 2</u>: This Council also encourages the Division of Liquor Control of the Ohio Department of Commerce to approve an application for the transfer of a liquor license that is to be filed by Seven-Fifty ML, LLC for this project.

<u>Section 3</u>: The City Manager is authorized to send a letter of support to the Ohio Department of Commerce, Division of Liquor Control, expressing the contents of this Resolution to the Division.

Section 4: This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council or its committees, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.

<u>Section 5</u>: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
