A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND AGREEING TO THE SEPARATION FROM EMPLOYMENT OF THE CITY MANAGER; AUTHORIZING ACTIONS RELATED THERETO; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Council and the current City Manager, Anthony J. Bales, wish to mutually agree to the separation from employment of Mr. Bales from the position of City Manager effective November 19, 2013; and

WHEREAS, certain documents may need to be executed as a result of that separation of the City Manager's employment from the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>: This Council hereby accepts and agrees to the mutual separation from employment of the City Manager, Anthony J. Bales, effective November 19, 2013, and authorizes the President of Council to execute any and all documents in furtherance thereof.

Section 2: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the general welfare of the City and for the further reason it is immediately necessary to accept and agree to the separation from employment of the current City Manager and to appoint a person to serve as Interim City Manager to continue the daily operations of the City; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council elected thereto or six affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
