Section 1: The Council of the City of Hudson hereby accepts the amounts and rates as set forth on the Summit County Budget Commission Certificate of Tax Levy attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

Section 2: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare and for the further reason that the Resolution must be in effect and submitted to the County Fiscal Officer by November 10, 2014; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council elected thereto or six affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
