A RESOLUTION ADOPTING IN CONCEPT THE UPDATED SIDEWALK AND TRAILS MASTER PLAN 2021-2025.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 14-12, passed by this Council on February 19, 2014, and Resolution No. 18-158, passed by this Council on December 4, 2018, the Connectivity Plan was adopted in concept; and

WHEREAS, the name of this plan shall be changed from the Connectivity Plan to the Sidewalk and Trails Master Plan; and the City has also proposed changes to the Plan as submitted; and the Park Board reviewed the plan with recommendations in a letter submitted October 22, 2020; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to adopt in concept the updated Sidewalk and Trails Master Plan for 2021-2025.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1:</u> The attached updated Sidewalk and Trails Master Plan is adopted by this Council and furthermore that it be understood that formal implementation of any of the projects or positions identified in this plan requires specific annual appropriation approval as provided in the City's Annual Appropriation Ordinance (Annual Budget) or any supplemental appropriation occurring throughout the year.

- <u>Section 2:</u> City Council agrees with the underlying process in which the priorities in the Plan were established.
 - <u>Section 3:</u> The Sidewalk and Trails Master Plan is to be updated periodically.
- <u>Section 4:</u> City Council and staff will focus, though not necessarily limit, their attention on the top-14 ranking segments as shown in the Plan.
- <u>Section 5:</u> It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
