

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CHANGE ORDER TO THE CONTRACT WITH RONYAK PAVING, INC. UNDER THE 2018 ASPHALT RESURFACING PROGRAM; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 17-157, adopted by this Council on October 17, 2017, the City Manager was authorized to advertise and bid the 2018 Capital Maintenance Programs, which included the 2018 Asphalt Resurfacing Program; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to public bid, this Council awarded the 2018 Asphalt Resurfacing Program contract to Ronyak Paving, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds that it is necessary to amend the aforesaid contract in accordance with the recommendation of the City Manager to authorize additional funds as a change order for the addition of certain City concrete streets to be overlaid with asphalt as an alternate to the current 2018 Asphalt Resurfacing Program contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: A change order in the amount of four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) to the 2018 Asphalt Resurfacing Program contract with Ronyak Paving, Inc., is approved.

Section 2: The Director of Finance is directed to appropriate to the proper accounts the funds necessary for the change order authorized in Section 1 of this Resolution.

Section 3: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to complete the alternate resurfacing roads work at the earliest possible time for the safety of the motoring public and to do so during this construction season; wherefore, this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council elected thereto, except that six (6) affirmative votes shall be required if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
